Wednesday, October 25, 7 a.m. through Saturday, November 4, 6 p.m.

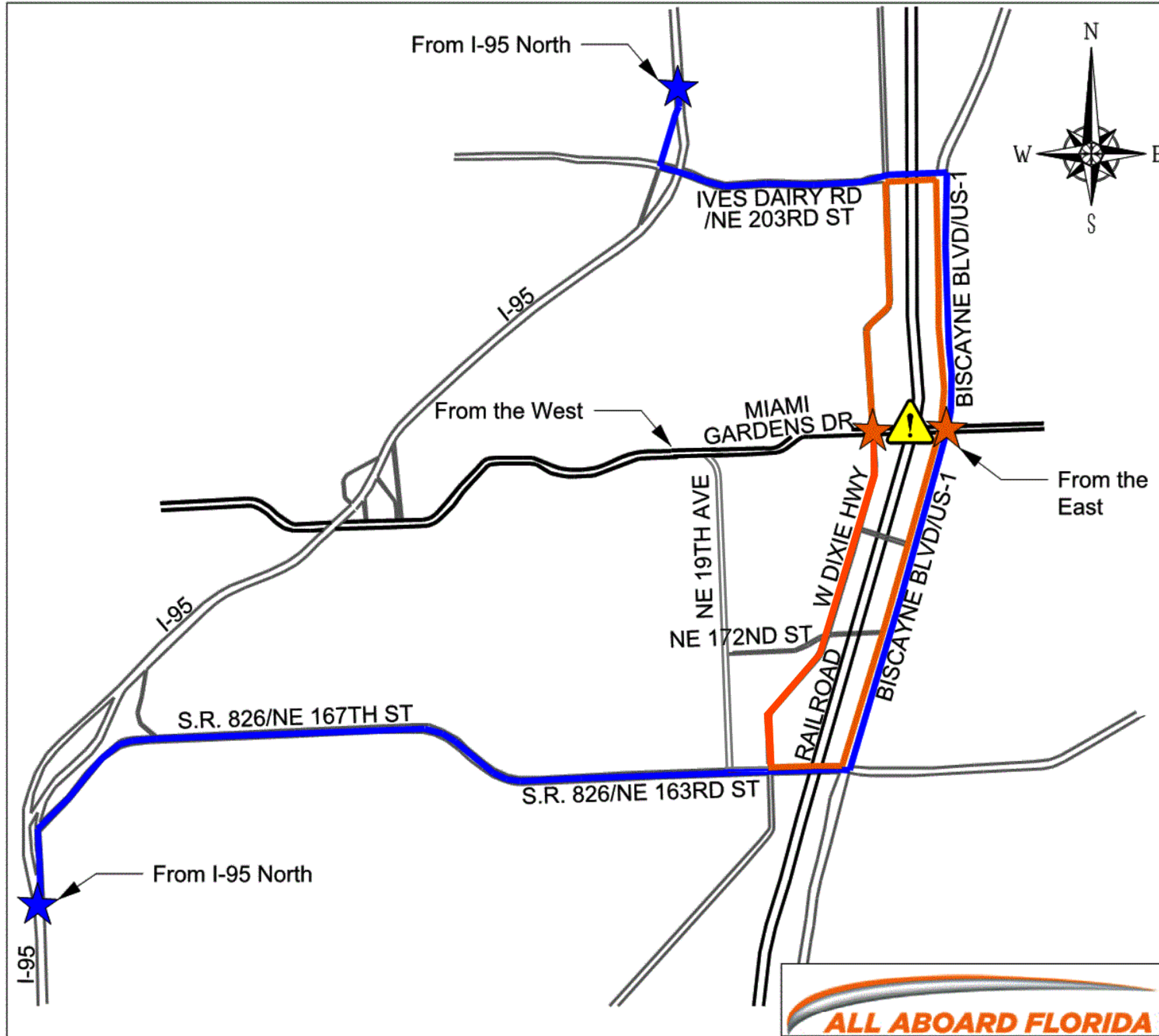

## Aventura



### From the East:

Travel north on Biscayne Boulevard/US-1, west on Ives Dairy Road/Northeast 203rd Street, and south on West Dixie Highway to return to Miami Gardens Drive.

### From the West:

Travel south on West Dixie Highway, east on SR 826/Northeast 163rd Street, and north on Biscayne Boulevard/US-1 to return to Miami Gardens Drive.





### From I-95 North:

Take exit 12b for S.R. 826/Northeast 163rd Street. Travel east on S.R. 826/Northeast 163rd Street and north on Biscayne Boulevard/US-1 to return to Miami Gardens Drive.

### From I-95 South:

Take exit 16 for Ives Dairy Road/Northeast 203rd Street. Travel east on Ives Dairy Road/Northeast 203rd Street and south on Biscayne Boulevard/US-1 to return to Miami Gardens Drive.
